NEW IDENTIFICATION GUIDELINES AS OF September 1, 2022

The following criteria shall be used in screening and placement of students for the Gifted Program (CAPS) in Clinton Public Schools.

## Grades 6-8

Step One	Universal Screener: All students will be screened with the MAP test.	Students scoring Advanced in ELA and/or Math.	If met, students proceed to step two.
Step Two	Teacher recommendation: <b>SIGS</b> : Scales for Identifying Gifted Students	Score of 110 or above	If met, proceed with step three.
Step Three	Students will be given the <b>SAGES</b> screening tool for Reasoning/creativity	Score of 111 or above.	If met, proceed with step four.
Step Four	Achievement Testing: <b>NWEA</b> test.	90th percentile or above	If a student meets the 90th percentile or above they are eligible to move on to step five.
Step Five	Intelligence Testing: WISC-IV	95th percentile or above on full scale IQ	If the student meets the 95th percentile and has met all five steps they are eligible for the Gifted program.
